Statistics for 2000 - 2001(TERI study)

- » Annual brick production more than 140 billion
- » Number of brick kiln units more than 1 lakh
- » 80 100 million people employed mostly migratory
- » Annual coal consumption about 24 million tonnes
- » Estimated CO₂ generation 42 million tonnes
- » Top soil consumption more than 400 million tones
- » Estimates for 2012
- » Annual brick production 290 billion
- » Annual Coal consumption 50 million tonnes









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Issues and challenges

- » Mechanisation
 - > Focused research on green brick molding
 - + around the year operation
 - + Large size low density product
 - > Incentives for adoption of mechanization to support experimentation
- » Capacity building
 - > Firemen, Moulders, Supervisors and brick kiln entrepreneurs
 - > Masons
 - > Development of local service providers (LSPs) to cater to varying needs of the industry product, fuel and soil characteristics
- » Financing
 - > Sector specific / tailor made financial packages
