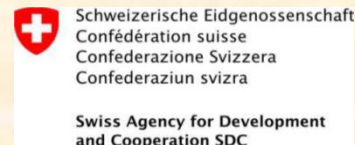

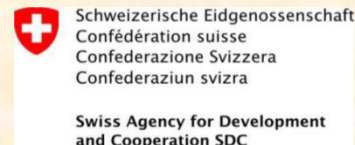

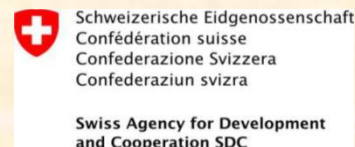

6th Energy Management Action Network (EMAK) Workshop



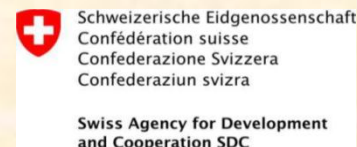
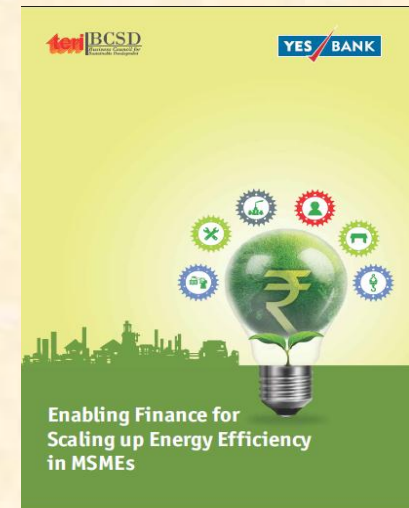
- ❖ Organized in collaboration with IEEJ at New Delhi on 25 February 2015

- ❖ Presentations available on IEA website



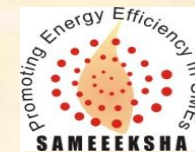
Knowledge paper on 'Enabling Finance for Scaling up Energy Efficiency in MSMEs'

- ❖ Released by Mr Jayant Sinha, Hon'ble Minister of State for Finance, GoI at the High Level Corporate Dialogue during TERI's flagship event- DSDS held in Feb 2015
- ❖ Paper outlines a way forward for key stakeholders to promote EE finance
- ❖ Provides recommendations to scale up financing for EE technologies based upon their stage of commercialization

❖ *Case study templates*

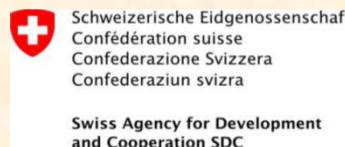
- Finalized templates for unit level and cluster level case study

- Linked websites of major organizations with SAMEEEKSHA website

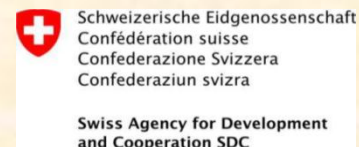
